

TIJMR – FINAL SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

Authors submitting revised manuscripts to **The International Journal of Multidisciplinary Research (TIJMR)** are requested to strictly follow the guidelines outlined below:

1. Similarity

- The **revised manuscript should not exceed 10% similarity**, including **AI-generated** content.
 - Ensure that **both content and language are original, with appropriate paraphrasing to** minimize overlap.

2. Reviewer Comments

- Authors must **address all reviewer comments point-by-point**.
 - Revisions should be clearly reflected in the manuscript.
 - A **detailed response letter** should accompany the submission, outlining how each comment was addressed.
-

3. Plagiarism Report

- The report should be **verified and duly signed**, confirming the similarity index is within the allowed limit (<10%).
-

4. Journal Formatting Guidelines

- The manuscript must be revised according to **TIJMR's formatting and editorial guidelines**.
 - This includes font, referencing style, figures, tables, headings, and citation formats as prescribed on the journal website.
-

5. Resubmission Deadline

- The following documents must be resubmitted **within 10 days** from the date of communication:
 - **Revised FINAL manuscript**
 - **Rebuttal letter to reviewers' comments**
